(How we use your information)

- 1. TC Young is committed to a policy of protecting the rights of individuals with respect to the processing of their personal data. We collect and use personal data for a variety of reasons.  - d. LinkedIn
 - e. Twitter
- 5. We will not share information about you with third parties.
- 6. We take steps internally and externally to ensure your data is looked after securely.
- Data retention guidelines on recruitment information mean we delete all information no later than 1 year after receipt.
- 8. You have the right at any time to:
 - Ask for a copy of the personal information about you held by us in our records; and
 - Ask us to correct any inaccuracies in your information
